

The Way I See It

I think it came with little surprise that on November 1, 2024, the Circuit Court of Cole County ruled in favor of MoDOT in their suit against the Office of Administration on the heels of the Missouri Supreme Court ruling in favor of the Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC) in a similar matter regarding their constitutional authority to spend funds. The timing of the decision could have a major impact on the 2024 legislative session as elected officials prepare to pre-file bills on December 1. Representative Don Mayhew has already stated that he plans to file legislation to revise the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission's (MHTC) authority over the road fund. With 2024 being an election year and with several lawmakers seeking statewide offices, the rhetoric and pandering will sure make the 2024 session interesting to say the least.

Dale Williams Some other legislation and developments we will be tracking this session include liability limit legislation which would provide liability caps to contractors working as agents of public entities, legislation that requires MoDOT to publish the engineer's estimate after the project is let and additional funding from General Revenue (GR) for low volume roads. As always, MAPA along with our lobby team at Husch Blackwell stand ready to protect the interests of our members, but we can't do it alone and as in years past we will need your help to defeat negative legislation and help promote additional funding and legislation that is favorable to our members. So, get involved and make plans to attend the MAPA lobby day this spring, date still pending, and join any calls to action. As I have stated in the past, our grass roots efforts have made a difference.


